Escorting THE WALL will be hundreds of veterans on motorcycles, most flying American Flags, showing their respect for the over 58,000 souls whose names are inscribed on THE WALL.

Civic organizations, civic leaders, businesses, churches and schools have been asked to mobilize their members and assemble at designated locations along the escort route.
